„Oberleutnant Erich Sommer's Arado Ar-234B Blitz“

Am 2. August 1944 startet Olt. Sommer mit einer ca. 740 km/h schnellen Arado 234 V7 zum ersten Aufklärungsflug auf 34000 ft ueber die die

franzoesische Cherbourg Halbinsel. Das Flugzeug war fuer die Alliierten nicht abfangbar. Ab Februar 1945 kommandierte Sommer eine mit Arado 234B ausgeruestete Aufklarungsstaffel an der italienischen Front. Limitierte Auflage 300 Exemplare, plus 30 Kuenstlerexemplare, signiert von Erich Sommer und dem Kuenstler. Blattformat ca. 79 cm x 58,5 cm

„Olt. Erich Sommer's Arado Ar-234B Blitz“

On the 2nd of August 1944 Olt. Sommer took off flying an Arado 234 V7, capable of ca. 450 mph, for the first reconnaissance mission over the french Cherbourg peninsula, climbing to 34000 ft. The aircraft was unreachable for the allied fighters. From February 1945 Sommer commanded his own reconnaissance unit equipped with Arado 234Bs at the italian front.
